Australian School of Tourism and Hotel Management Industry Educational Scholarships

Terms And Conditions

These Terms and Conditions form the basis of the Scholarship Contract. Terms and Conditions are applicable to all Australian School of Tourism and Hotel Management (ASTHM) scholars awarded an Industry Educational Scholarship.

If you have been fortunate enough to have been awarded a scholarship from Australian School of Tourism and Hotel Management, congratulations! This is a great achievement and we ask you to please note the few, but essential, terms and conditions of your scholarship:-

1. The scholarship panel decides twice a year who will be awarded a scholarship based on the application submitted, and are based on, as applicable, academic achievements, sports achievements, references, evidence of voluntary work completed, etc.
2. A maximum of \$100 000.00 in Educational Scholarships are available to be awarded annually commencing 1st July each year
3. Eligible courses include; Hotel Management, Tourism Management and Meeting and Events Management.
4. Only students who are enrolled at ASTHM for a minimum of 2 years of study and who have completed a minimum of 1 semester will be eligible to apply for a scholarship.
5. Scholarship values will be determined as follows:
 - a. Bronze Scholarship 25% Tuition fee for 1 semester of study.*
 - b. Silver Scholarship 50% Tuition fee for 1 semester of study.*
 - c. Gold Scholarship 75% Tuition fee for 1 semester of study.*
 - d. Platinum Scholarship 100% Tuition fee for 1 semester of study.*
6. Scholarship Application Forms must be completed and submitted no later than week 17 semester 1 of studies.
7. Scholarships will be awarded based on a range of selection criteria determined during semester 1 of the studies including:
 - a. Quality of student application
 - b. Student academic performance
 - c. Lecturer commendation
 - d. Student attendance
 - e. Class and Industry participation
8. Scholarships will be awarded for tuition only and will not be redeemable for cash.
9. Successful applicants will be notified by week 20 of semester 1 of study.
10. Scholarships are non-transferable and cannot be deferred.
11. Reasons for not being awarded a scholarship are not provided, as resources do not permit.
12. The period of time the scholarship is offered for is clearly stated and not extendable.
13. The scholarship is for the ONE named person and Australian School of Tourism and Hotel Management will not be responsible for a scholar's family members/spouse/children, etc. and if a scholar wishes to have a family member accompany him/her, they must be aware that this is solely their responsibility and they will be required to pay all costs incurred by the additional family member/s.
14. Scholarship students will sign a scholarship contract (Terms and Conditions within) with the Australian School of Tourism and Hotel Management.
15. The Australian School of Tourism and Hotel Management likes to celebrate its' excellence and will be requesting to interview you and arrange for you to have your portrait taken by the Australian School of Tourism and Hotel Management photographer (usually arranged separately).
16. All scholars will agree to allow us to share certain data (name, course, student ID number, institution, etc. as required) with other parties within the Australian School of Tourism and Hotel Management. We may also use information collected regarding the scholars in our Australian School of Tourism and Hotel

Management's Marketing activities; however, students' addresses and telephone numbers will not be given out without prior written permission from the student.

17. We may feature your interview/photo/profile/story on the Australian School of Tourism and Hotel Management website and/or other Australian School of Tourism and Hotel Management publications without asking for any further permission/approval from you prior to publishing this.
18. The Australian School of Tourism and Hotel Management reserves the right to utilise this information in the promotion of the Australian School of Tourism and Hotel Management and in any other student recruitment and/or Scholarship promotion activities.
19. Please note that when requested scholars are required to show originals (not photocopies) of transcripts and documents submitted in evidence with their scholarship application, and present these to the Admissions office, if there is any question of authenticity. If, after checking, we discover any documents that are NOT 100% genuine, the scholarship award will immediately be invalidated and withdrawn. The Australian School of Tourism and Hotel Management accepts NO liability in this case.
20. It is the scholar's responsibility to set a good example and to at all times strive for best results, achieve outstanding attendance and continue to demonstrate the exemplary student attributes/grades by which he/she was awarded the scholarship.
21. All scholars are required to take part in no less than six (6) ASTHM promotional and marketing activities per annum. All activities will be advised to the scholar with no less than 4 weeks notice.
22. The Australian School of Tourism and Hotel Management reserves the right to investigate and possibly withdraw a person from the scholarship programme, if there is adequate proven evidence or serious allegations of illegal conduct including plagiarism, law breaking activities.
23. The decision on allocation of scholarships is made by the Management Committee and is final. No correspondence may be entered into.

* 1 semester is determined as no less than 17 weeks duration.
